• EDC 2901 – PRACTICUM I

Student will undergo a Practicum I in the third (3rd) semester of Year 3 for 4 weeks. The SOP is one-week exposure programme, proceeding a three-week First Phase of Teaching Practice. Students are required to continue their practicum in the selected schools for another three weeks to complete the First Phase of Teaching Practice.

• EDC 4903 - PRACTICUM II (TEACHING PRACTICE)

After completing all courses (major and minor courses), students are eligible to undergo Practicum II for 12 weeks. The objective is to enable students to practice and apply the concepts, skills, principles previously learned during training. They should preferably be asked to teach subjects related to their field specialization. They may however, teach other school subjects if required by the school they are attached to. Supervisors may also observe them teaching these subjects but only for the purpose of giving guidance and counseling but NOT for evaluation.

• EDG 3903 – COUNSELING PRACTICUM

Students will undergo Counseling Practicum in the third (3rd) semester of Year 3. This initial placement at a counseling site (school or agency) is aimed to give the students an opportunity to make observations on a real counseling setting. Students are required to spend a total of 240 hours in the practicum and weekly on-campus supervisions.

• EDG 4904 - COUNSELING INTERNSHIP

After completing all courses (major and minor), students are eligible to undergo a Counseling Internship. The internship is a field experience in which students apply knowledge and skills needed for successful practice as school or agency counselors. It is comprises of 500 hours on-site under the supervision of an approved site supervisor who is a practicing counselor. As part of 500 hours, interns are to have a minimum of 200 hours of direct contact with clients.
